Dear Parliamentary Secretary for Justice

Re: The covering up of fraud

I refer to your letter of even date (copy **attached**).

It appears that we go around in circles. You wrote to me on 13th August 2013 stating that Terence Goldberg, solicitor, acted for the sixth defendant in Supreme Court proceedings 2009/00291458-001. This statement as made by you was, and remains, totally false. A very simple telephone call to the Supreme Court of NSW can and will ascertain such. As was previously made known to you, the sixth defendant was an unrepresented party in those proceedings.

Terence Goldberg's claim that he acted for the sixth defendant in such proceedings is also false. As you also well know, Terence Goldberg acted for the four plaintiffs in the matter and his claim to have acted for the sixth defendant was both untruthful and fraudulent, with such claim apparently being made in order to create a debt where no debt was in fact owed.

As stated in my E-mail to the Minister for Police of 31st August 2018, the remaining monies belonging to the sixth defendant, which should be in the region of \$700,000.00, have made their way to the given home address of two long-time acquaintances of Terence Goldberg, with such address also being the registered address of a sham entity, as set up by Mr Goldberg.

It should be made known to you that John McKenzie, the Legal Services Commissioner, in correspondence of 17th November 2017, states:

"...arising from Mr Goldberg's representation of the late Reverend Patricia Cleary and other members of the Enmore Spiritualist Church Incorporated in relation to the litigation that concluded in 2009 and subsequent dissolution of the Church."

As can be plainly seen, the Legal Services Commissioner admits that Terence Goldberg acted for individuals only in the matter, however, despite Mr McKenzie's admission of the fact, he has never requested of Mr Goldberg his reasons for making the false and fraudulent statement that he acted for the incorporated association in question (among others).

Please find **attached** my response of 27th November 2017 to Mr McKenzie's letter of 17th November 2017. You will note that Mr McKenzie did not provide any response, as is his way.

As also stated in my E-mail to the Minister for Police of 31st August 2018, the turning of a blind eye to this issue goes very high indeed, with people such as yourself willing to provide false statements to members of the public in order to cover up wrongdoing and to protect the perpetrators of such wrongdoing. The question needs to be raised as to why you, and certain others, insist on doing so.

This charade must come to an end.

I copy this letter to the Minister for Police, the External Liaison Unit of the Professional Standards Command of the NSW Police, and to the Law Enforcement Conduct Commission.
