***Re: Dishonest conduct - covering up of criminal activity***


You have provided no comment to my letter to you of 14<sup>th</sup> April 2022, nor to my knowledge have you fulfilled the statutory requirements as set down in sections 465(2)(a) and 465(2)(b) of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law* (NSW).

It is more than obvious that you are unwilling to fulfil your duties as Legal Services Commissioner. You have been providing favour to Terence Goldberg for quite some time, and indeed it has been more than obvious for quite some time. Without any sense of irony or shame, you wrote to me on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2015 and complained that you were insulted and offended at the suggestion that you were acting corruptly, while knowing full well that you were doing so.

Let us look at your letter of 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2015 (copy **attached**). In such, you admit that Terence Goldberg has made false statements, however, you provide the caveat that perhaps Mr Goldberg had done so mistakenly, or perhaps he did so on instruction from his clients (while in dispute with same), and yet you have never once asked Mr Goldberg as to why he has done so. You are fully aware that such false statements provided Mr Goldberg and his associates with substantial and fraudulent financial gain.

Let us come back to sections 465(2)(a) and 465(2)(b) of the LPUL which state that you must report suspected offences to the NSW Police. You consistently refuse to do so. Yet, you had no such qualms in contacting and sending the NSW Police to my front door while claiming to be harassed by my writing to you. Your conduct requires examination.
